

Questions that will be asked in the NYWOD application

In 400 words or less, please summarize what your project was about.

Be sure to include: information on why you chose the project, the issues the project addressed, who your target audience was, and the project's outcome.

In 400 words or less, please describe how your project had measurable and sustainable impact.

Be sure to talk about: the people or living things impacted by your project. Also touch on the project's sustainability and the likelihood of it continuing beyond the current time frame. *(Use numbers and data if needed.)*

In 400 words or less, please describe how your project had a local connection to a national or global issue.

Be sure to indicate: the global relevance of the local issue you tackled for your project. For example, if you did a hunger drive at your local church, the global relevance is that hunger is a worldwide issue. Detail how you feel about this issue.

In 400 words or less please describe the impact completing your Gold Award project has had on you.

Be sure to include: what new skills you may have gained, what qualities you have learned about yourself and how these discoveries will help you in the future.
