1. Adopt a trail and keep it trimmed and well marked.
2. Adopt a unit and keep it clean, polished, easy use ideas.
3. Make wood-bins or wood racks for dry wood for each campsite/unit.
4. Split, carry and stack wood to each unit.
5. Make picnic tables.
6. Adopt or create flower beds – clean, plant, mulch.
7. Clean and organize all storage areas behind picnic areas.
8. Scrub washstands with bleach.
9. Scrub latrines.
10. Power wash and paint picnic tables (camp wide).
11. Build shelves in the cook shelters.
12. Clean inside of Lodge by washing windows, dusting fans, scrubbing sinks, etc.
13. Design and plant perennial flower gardens.
14. Paint inside of latrines.
15. Make benches.
16. Build flag stand and purchase flag(s) for each lodge.
17. Spray paint all shovels, brooms, rakes, dustpans.
18. Develop memory garden.
19. Make wooden benches.
20. Research and write up history of camp.
