### A Study of Social and Communication Development

**What:** We are looking for volunteers (ages 4-18 years) to help us develop a

measure of social language difficulties on a general population to provide a comparison for kids and teens with ASD. We hope this will help to secure services and supports for those with social language difficulties (namely, ASD). Social difficulties are more difficult to measure as children get older (into school age) so services get cut while the mental health concerns of the children and teens grow. We are hopeful this measure could help justify additional supports for people with autism and social difficulties.

We hope participation could align with badge requirements, with a talk or activity about autism or research for the troop. If participants prefer, a gift card can also be offered to thank them for their time. THANK YOU for your interest!
