

## DISCOVER THE NATION'S CAPITAL PATCH – TRANSPORTATION SEGMENT

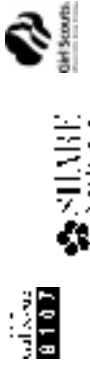
Visit at least five sites including one from each of the four categories plus one of your choice.

### I. By LAND

- Mt. Vernon**  
Ride your bike on the bike path to Mt. Vernon
- American Museum of American History**  
Visit the exhibit on trains.
- National Trolley Museum**  
Take a visit and see one of the fun ways we traveled before the bus and Metro.
- Arts and Industries Building in the Smithsonian Institution**  
Visit the Horse Drawn Carriage
- Metro and Bus**  
While in Washington, ride the Metro and or a Metro bus during your visit.
- Rollerblades**  
Ride your rollerblades around the District and enjoy the beautiful gardens.
- 2. By AIR**  
**National Air and Space Museum**  
Check out the exhibit on balloon flight on the second floor.
- Airport, College Park, Maryland**  
Visit the country's oldest operating airport.

- Andrews Air Force Base**  
Check out the visitor's center. Is Air Force One there?
- Goddard Space Center**  
Visit the space exhibits at the Center and see how the Space Shuttles are tracked.
- Dulles Airport**  
Take the shuttle between terminals and count the number of international airlines you see parked on the tarmac.
- National Airport**  
Go to National Airport and see the inlaid floor mosaics.
- 3. On WATER**  
**C & O Canal National Park**  
Take a walk along the towpath. If it is summer, ride the canal boat at the Tavern at Great Falls.
- Tidal Basin**  
Ride the paddleboats on the Tidal Basin.
- Navy Museum**  
Find the replica of John Paul Jones' ship in the museum.

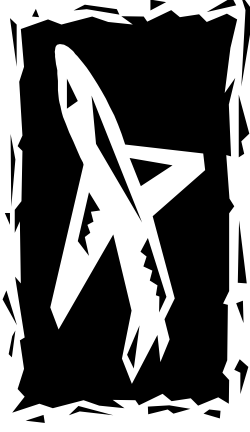
**Potomac River Cruise**  
Contact one of the companies and take a scenic cruise down the Potomac River. Cruises are available at Riverfront Park at the end of Wisconsin Ave.

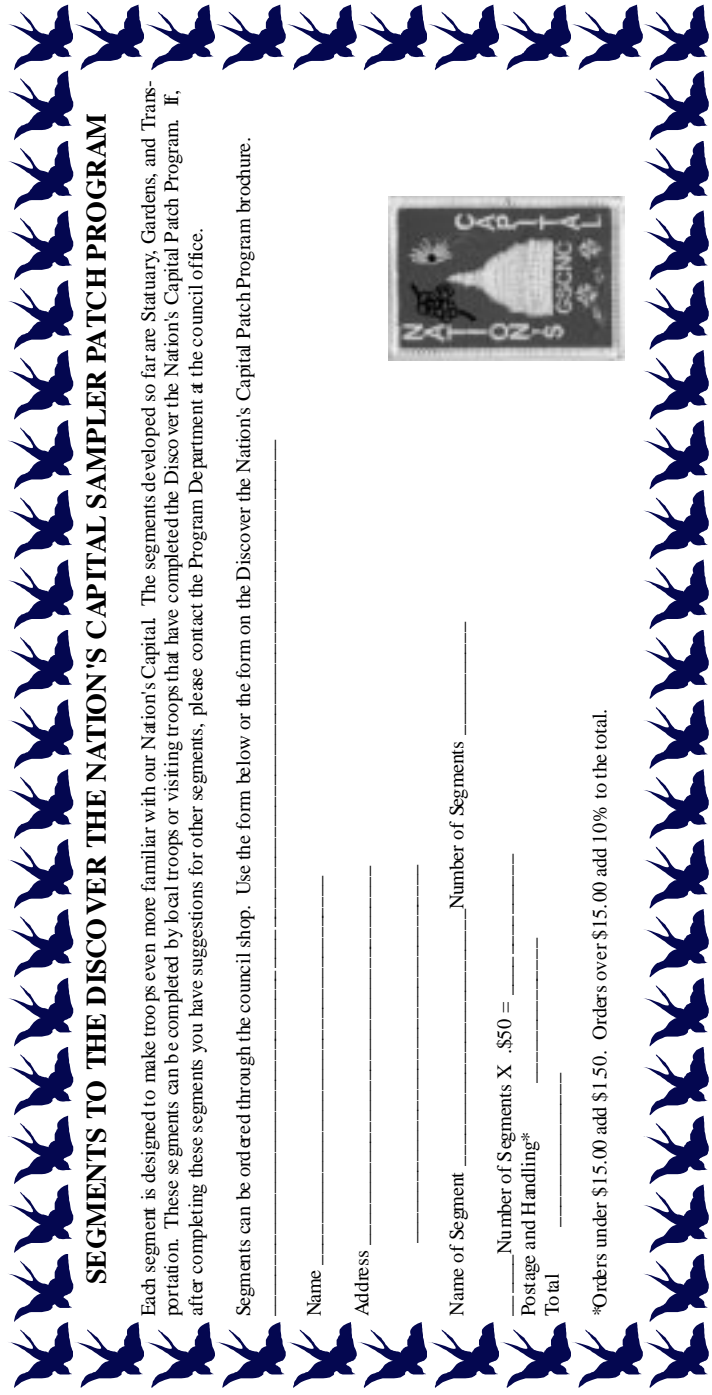
**White's Ferry**
