#### Be a Go-Getter! Make sure your Event Registration login is up to date!

Go to <a href="www.gscnc.org">www.gscnc.org</a> and click the Ebiz link on the top right hand corner to login to your account. Below are some tips to make sure you have a stress free registration for upcoming events and programs:

- Confirm the email address you provided is correct, registrants receive all communication via email the email address linked to their registration.
- Make sure all the girls who want to register are listed in your troop or family.
- Discuss the program with the girls/parents prior to registering and only register girls who have made a commitment to attend.
