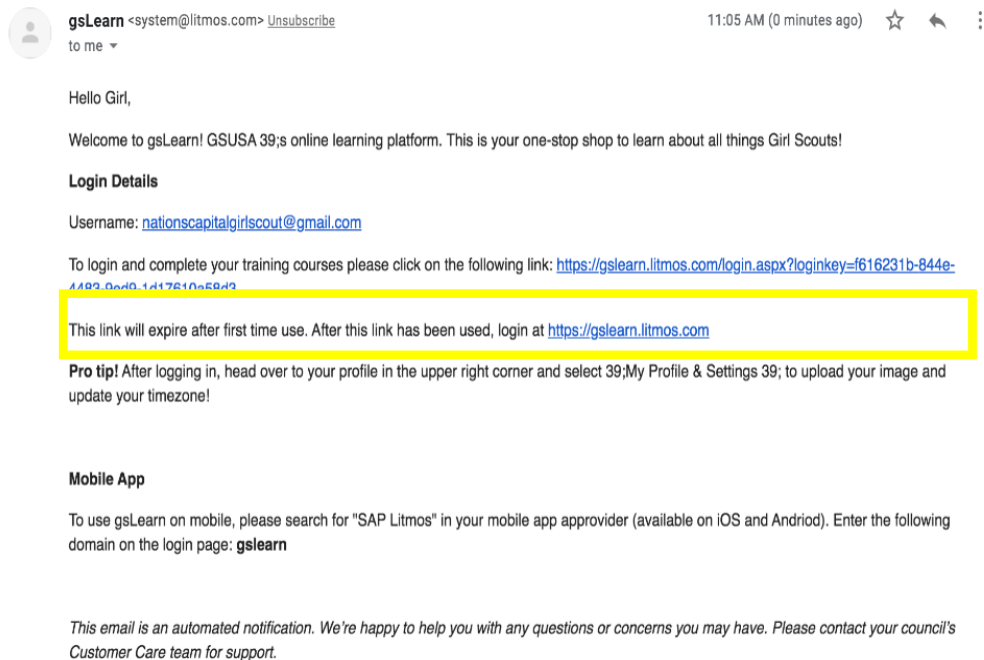


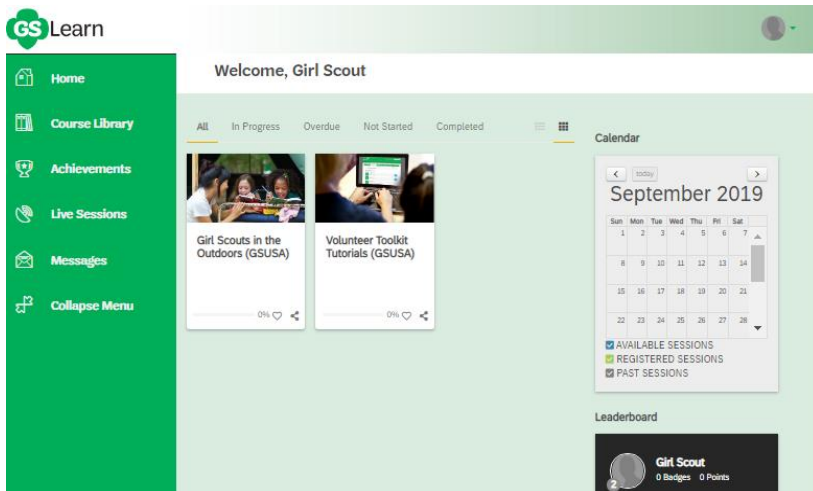
gsLearn Log-in Instructions

1. All volunteers will receive an email invitation from system@litmos.com with their username (email from My GS Sign In) and a link to finish setting up their account.

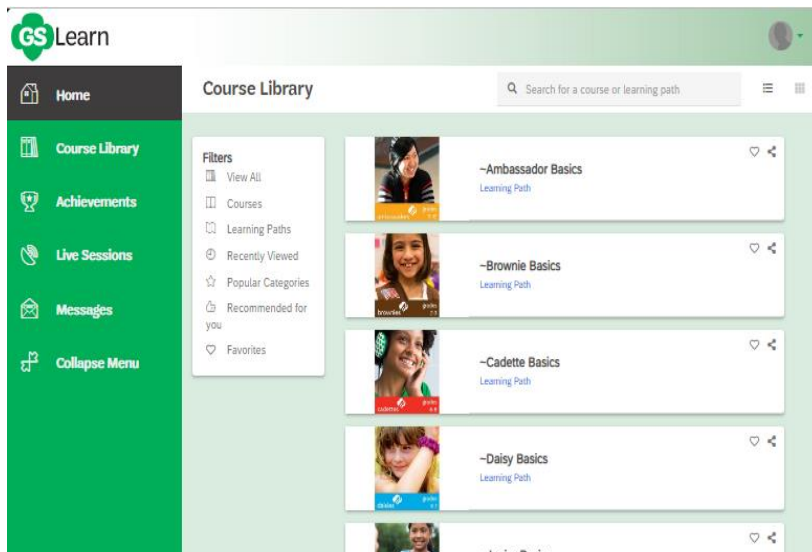


2. Volunteers will create their password. **TIP:** To make this easier to remember, make it match your My GS Sign In password!

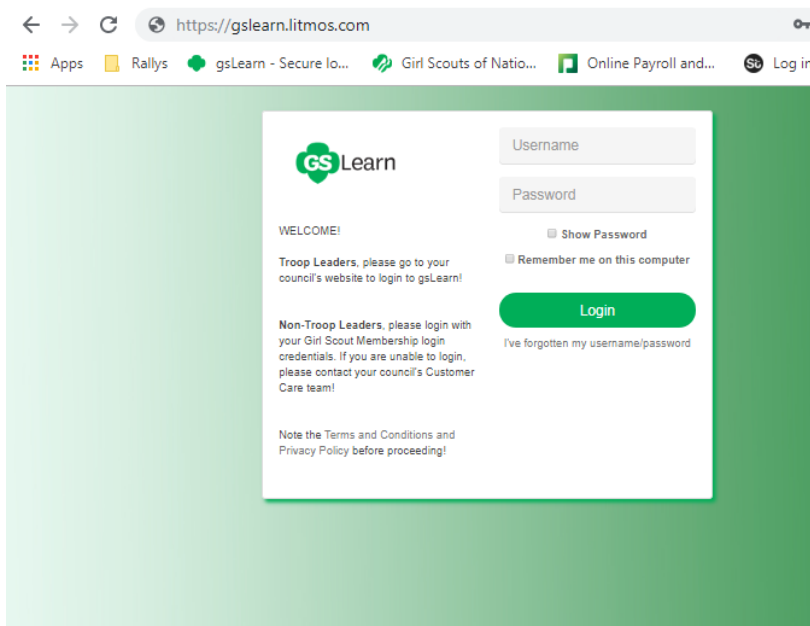
