



Quick Guide: Silver Trefoil

Who: A Girl Scout can begin to work on hours toward the Silver Trefoil as a rising Cadette, Senior, or Ambassador but cannot earn more than 50 hours as a Cadette. The Award must be completed as a Senior or Ambassador.

What: An Award unique to Girl Scouts Nation's Capital, the Silver Trefoil recognizes a Girl Scout who completes 100 hours of community service.

When: Must be completed prior to September 30th of the year a Girl Scout graduates from high schooll

How: 1. Read the Silver Trefoil Guidelines and set your service goals

- 2. Complete the required 100 hours of service across the 3 categories being sure to carefully log all of your hours!
 - a. Girl Scout Community Hours
 - b. National Service Hours
 - c. Global Service Hours
- 3. Complete the online Silver Trefoil Report Submission form, found on the GSCNC website
- 4. You've earned your Silver Trefoil Award!
