Your art could even be featured on a Hard Rock Cafe pin!

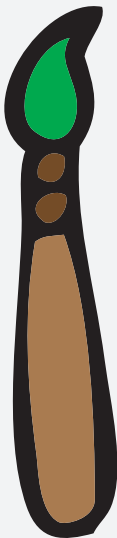
feeling creative?

- Your artwork must include the artist name, age, city, state and Service Unit, email, phone number and troop leader's information.
- Your artwork must be no larger than 28 in. x 28 in.
- Finalists will be notified that they've made it to the top. Artwork not chosen as a finalist will be available for pickup in the Council office.
- Artwork will be judged based on its creativity and representation of the spirit of the 100th anniversary of Girl Scouting.
