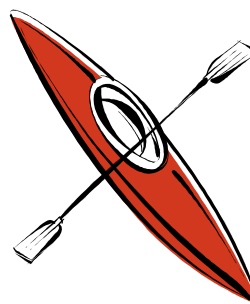

Bring your girls out to sample some of our high adventure activities. No experience is necessary! Trained instructors and/or lifeguards will be provided.

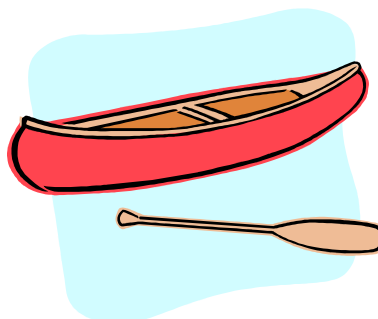
