

# Thank you for using the Pixie List!

This site is a great way for volunteers and community members to support Girl Scouting. Use the information below when using this site:

- Create your ad with positive, compelling words and phrases to explain your opportunity or need
- Be sure to include your location, time constraints, appropriate age levels and any associated costs
- Refrain from Girl Scout specific jargon or abbreviations (Journeys, try-its, GSLE)
- Be specific; refrain from only asking for general job titles like "Troop Leader."
- Be detailed about duties and logistics
- Notify [pixielistwatchdog@gscnc.org](mailto:pixielistwatchdog@gscnc.org) when your ad should be removed

## Safety Tips

- Troop Leaders and Advisors are responsible for reviewing safety guidelines in *Volunteer Essentials*, before they leave their meeting site. Even then, they continue to be the "adult in charge"
- Knowledge of Girl Scout policies is not required to post or reply to offerings on the Pixie List
- Refrain from posting detailed personal information such as home addresses and phone numbers
- When meeting with new volunteers or exchanging materials, meet during the day in a public place

## Strong Examples

The activities will meet the requirements of the World Neighbors Junior Badge, and the badge is included. Cost is \$17 per girl and is sponsored by Ambassador Troop 5074 as a money earning event.
