

## Around the World with Girl Scouts at Camp White Rock

Explore Camp White Rock while you follow the clues and learn about Girl Guides and Girl Scouts around the world as you go! Don't forget to record all 10 stamps and leave us a message in the journal at the end. (You may want to take a camp map along with you.)

**1:** Start from the trail on the Nature Center's right hand. Look for the box where the water flows behind the Nature Center.

**2:** Return to the main road and head toward the Quiet Place. Pass the Touch Tree and head for the Wishing Well. Rest to the left and look beneath you.

**3:** In true Pioneer spirit, travel behind Sherwood until you cross over two pipes, then stop at the back entrance of Sherwood unit. Head East for 10 paces and look between two rocks resting in the shade.

**4:** Continue up the main road until you're ready for the show. Look behind the wood shed to travel to Germany.

**5:** Feeling ready for a refreshing dip? Don't forget to rinse in the shower! Look for a message from a Burundi visitor where the blacktop sidewalk ends.

**6:** Take the dotted trail toward the Bluff overlooking the Cacapon River. Stand on lookout boulder and listen to the song of the river. Then turn around and spot the bird house to your left. Look at the base of that tree, snuggled with the fence.

**7:** Double back on the path and travel past Cooper's Lodge to Girl Scout Run. Pay a toll to cross the Wishing Bridge (a wish!) and look for Portugal at the base of a tree on the other side. Can you hear the falls whispering to you?

**8:** Continue onward up the path for the best view of the river. Stand by the transformer in the middle of the field. Head East for 20 paces and look near the base of the second little tree.

**9:** Head back toward main camp. Look for the smallest triangle on the right side of the dry bridge to learn about Columbia.

**10:** Can you hear the bell ringing for chow time? Pass by the bell and look for the last box to the left of the first tree stump on the left of the path. You did it! 😊
