ROLE:

- Consult, advise, and support troop leaders/advisors in developing quality girl programs
- Act as a liaison between the troops/groups and the service unit (SU) team, community organization, or other delivery system

**DUTIES AND
RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Assist troop leaders/advisors in understanding the basic concepts of Girl Scouting and the troop leader's/advisor's role
2. Work with troop leaders/advisors to identify existing skills and potentials
3. Remain familiar with current GSCNC and GSUSA programs
4. Work with the SU and help troop leaders/advisors begin and become increasingly competent with the job
5. Acquaint troop leaders/advisors with program activities and community resources and help them enhance and evaluate the program
6. Share knowledge and skills with troop leaders/advisors regularly
7. Implement Girl/Adult partnership concept
8. Work with troop leaders/advisors to understand GSCNC and GSUSA policies and standards as they pertain to the program needs of individual troops
9. Encourage troop leaders/advisors to participate in training opportunities

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Register as an adult member of the Girl Scouts of the United States of America
2. Complete the Volunteer Position Application process
3. Accept and adhere to the purpose and principles of Girl Scouting
4. Show a willingness to work with diverse groups with varying lifestyles and cultures in a positive manner
5. Recognize, understand, accept, interpret, and support all council goals, policies, guidelines and objectives, including the Human Relations Policy Statement
6. Complete required training
7. Owe no outstanding debts to the council

METHOD OF SELECTION:

- Selected and appointed by the SUM

ACCOUNTABILITY:

- Accountable to the SUM
- Periodically responsible to SU event coordinators

TERM OF POSITION:

- Appointed annually
