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**APPLICATION FOR
225 LIGHTWEIGHT CAMPING
REQUALIFICATION or TRANSFER QUALIFICATION**

In the Girl Scout Council of Nation's Capital, Outdoor Camping skills must be requalified every three years. This form can be used for two purposes: (1) an application for consideration for 225-I, Immediate Requalification, or (2) a registration form for a 225 Requalification course. See details below for requirements.

1. Do you qualify for consideration for 225-I?

To qualify for consideration for 225-I:

- You have taken 225 Requalification (in this council) within the past 3 years

AND

- You have camped actively with girls in the last three years.

I you do not meet these requirements. Skip to #2 below.

If you do meet these requirements:

Your application must be sent by mail to a trainer on the 225 Trainer Resource List. This list IS NOT available on the website. This list may be obtained by requesting it either via e-mail to: kstevenson@gscnc.org or by calling extension #250. The volunteer trainer will review your application and will notify you if you qualify for an immediate Requalification or if you should attend a 225 class. YOU MUST be as specific as possible with dates and locations and YOU MUST submit a copy of your training card. Remember: 225-I is granted based on activity within the past 3 years.

2. Do you qualify to take a 225 Requalification Course?

To qualify for a 225 Requalification Course:

- You have taken 215 Backcountry Camping or 250 LightWeight Camping not more than three years ago (a grace period of 6 months past expiration is allowed);

OR

- You have equivalent and CURRENT (within past three years) camp qualification gained with another youth group or council but have not taken outdoor training in this council.

If you meet these requirements:

A 225 Requalification course will allow you to requalify the 250 Lightweight Camping (formerly 215 Backcountry Camping) certification. (Alternatively, you may choose to take 260 Backpacking.)

If you are transferring from another youth group or council, before taking 225 you must take:

**101 Basic Leadership Training

To register:

1. Consult the current Training Calendar or Update to find out when the next 225 class is being held.

2. Complete this application and send or fax it to GSCNC Training Registration (address & fax listed above. This application serves as your registration for the specific 225 course(s) you request.
**Make sure you fill out the course ID # (page 1) for the class you are registering for.
3. Applications must be received by the “Please register by” date for your course listed in the Training Calendar. Since the registrants teach portions of the course, this date allows enough time for the trainers to contact registrants, and for registrants to prepare.
