DIRECTIONS TO ANACOSTIA/URBAN TREE HOUSE SITE: Head east on I-395 following signs to I-295/MLK Avenue. Shortly after crossing the 11th St. Bridge, make a right turn onto ramp identified as Anacostia Park. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp; turn right again at the next stop sign. Continue for 1 mile to the Anacostia Park Pavilion and Boat Ramp. Also accessible via the Anacostia Metro Stop on the green/yellow lines.
