# RULES OF ORDER

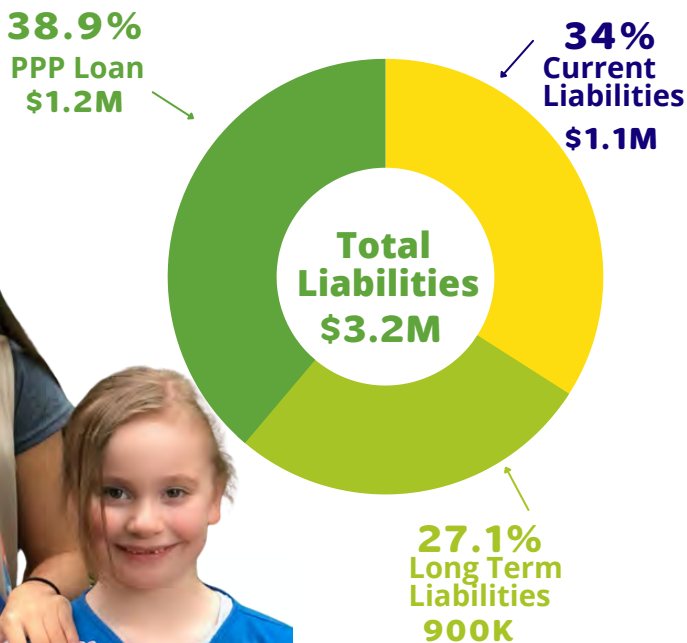
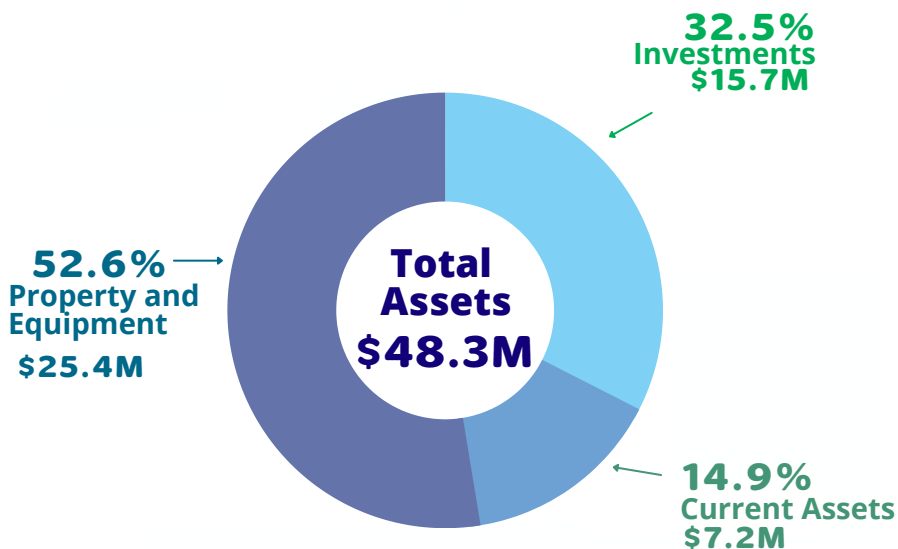
- ✿ All motions and resolutions shall be in written form and submitted to the Secretary.
- ✿ Speakers must state name and position.
- ✿ All remarks must be addressed to the Chair and must speak to the question under discussion.
- ✿ Each person speaking to a motion or resolution may have two minutes to speak.
- ✿ No one may speak twice until everyone wishing to speak has had the opportunity to do so.
- ✿ Questions regarding proposals to be considered at the meeting may be asked by the Council's Voting Members.
- ✿ Proposals considered at the Meeting are limited to those proposals specifically included in the notice of the meeting. Such proposals will be voted upon as presented.
- ✿ Each motion will be allotted five minutes; debates may be extended by a two-thirds vote or closed in less than five minutes by a motion to "call the question." A motion to call the question takes precedence over any motion on the floor and also requires a two-thirds vote. If the motion is passed, an immediate vote on the question at hand is called.

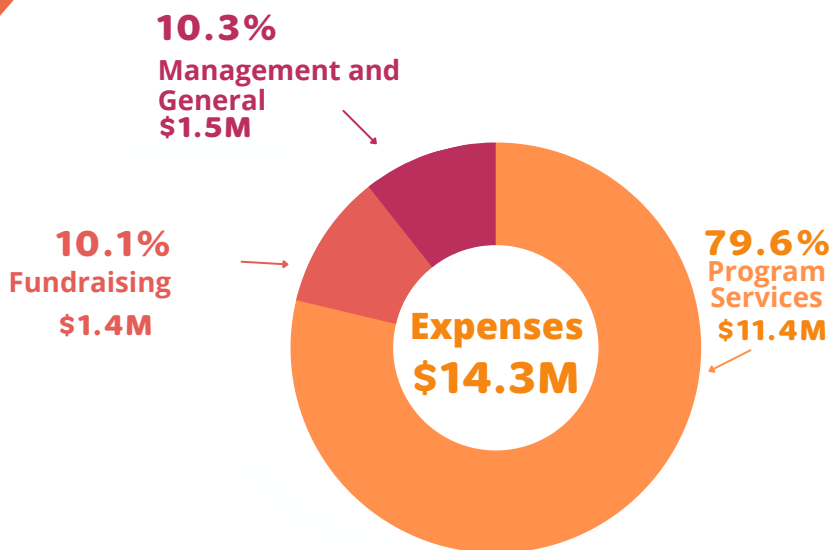
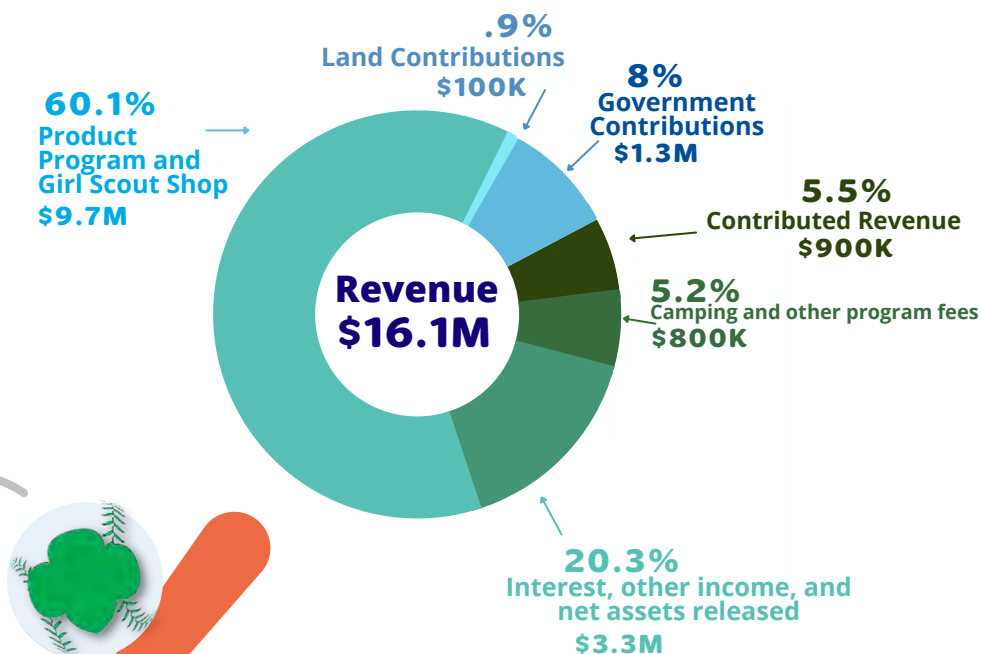

## Forum Questions

1. What steps can Girl Scouts take to create an organization of belonging?
2. What policies need to be altered to make other families feel welcome and empowered?

Offer materials in multiple languages.

Increase the diversity of language, culture, skin color, ability, and gender represented in both marketing materials and patches.

Better accommodate parents and families to allow for increased involvement by hosting more family events.

Provide resources for troop conversations about inclusion that include tips and training resources.

Ensure that inclusion and diversity training is inclusive and that experts are available for training at the Service Unit level.

Decrease the organization's financial burden and ensure that financial aid is discreet and easy to access.

Increase the focus on cultural and social justice events, badges, and patches.

Address the gender spectrum by promoting that Girl Scouts is a space for all.

Streamline the process for new volunteer training.

Provide easy access to council policies.

## Camp

Maintains our eight camps, high adventure activities and ensures every girl has the chance to enjoy the outdoors. \$1000 helps get girls to sleep away camp.

## Financial Assistance

Covers membership and troop dues, girl supplies, camperships, and program fees. \$500 supports a year of Girl Scouting.

## Programs

Supports troop and camp programs, STEM, life skills, entrepreneurship and leadership training. \$250 helps a girl travel on a Girl Scout destination.

## Volunteer Assistance

Provides free and reduced cost training for volunteers. \$100 helps a volunteer receive training and resources.
