## Car Transportation

More comfortable driving your camper? Parents/guardians can choose to drop off and pick up their camper by car. There is no opportunity for you to tour camp during drop-off/pick-up - plan to attend an [Open House](#) instead. Campers with drivers' licenses are **NOT** permitted to leave their vehicles at camp.



## Bus Transportation

Camp can start on the bus! Parents/guardians can save time and gas while Girl Scouts enjoy singing songs, chatting, and bonding with fellow campers. Campers enjoy taking the bus to transition into the new camp environment.

Prices for bus transportation will be shared in May.

We plan to run a Maryland and Virginia Bus Stop. The Maryland bus stop will most likely be at Cresthaven Elementary School in Silver Spring, MD. The Maryland bus stop will only be for Camp May Flather. The Virginia bus stop has been finalized and will be at the Fairfax County Government Center in Fairfax, VA. The Virginia bus stop will be for both Camp May Flather and Camp Potomac Woods. If we do not meet the minimum number of campers needed for a bus, you will be notified **two weeks prior** to the start of your camper's camp session.

**As of June 26, due to low enrollment, we will NOT be offering bus service to camp Potomac Woods**

**Bus Transportation Availability** Bus transportation will NOT be available during **any half-week programs at Potomac Woods (sessions 4 and 8 – July 3-8 and July 31 – August 5).**

**Can I mix and match my transportation selections?** Yes, you can select bus one way and car one way to camp for your camper. However, please note that the price for bus transportation remains the same, no matter if your camper is taking the bus once or both times. You may not mix and match bus stop locations, however.

**Late Arrivals** If your camper will be arriving late, please notify the camp office as soon as you know there will be a schedule conflict. Let them know if you will miss check-in and your anticipated time of arrival. Please report to the camp office (or designated area) upon arrival for late check-in.

**Early Departures** If your camper will be leaving camp early, please notify staff during check-in so we may have your camper and their belongings ready when you arrive. We will only release campers to adults listed on the [Pick-Up Authorization Form](#) (including parents/guardians). Please report to the camp office or designated area for early pickup. If you know now that your camper will be leaving early, include it on your [Pick-Up Authorization Form](#).

#### May Flather: 10:00 AM–10:45 AM

#### Potomac Woods: 12:45 PM – 1:30 PM

- Bus leaves at 1:45 PM

### Friday Pick Up

#### May Flather: 7:15 PM

- Adult picking up must arrive by 7 PM

- Adult picking up must arrive by 6:15 PM

The person **picking up** your camper must show their **Photo ID** and be listed on the [Authorized Pick-Up Form](#) (even parents/guardians). They will:

- Sign out your camper
- Pick up all medications
- Pick up all luggage - check that your camper has all their bags - including the dirty clothes bag, bedding, and camper care kit (if ordered).

**List a current phone number and email on your camper's health forms.** We use this number to contact you if you are running late to camp or to the bus stop. We will make every attempt to contact you for one hour after pick-up time. If we have not heard from you within one hour of pick-up time, we will contact local authorities.
