## HOW TO REGISTER

This year, camp registration will be done through a new system, called gsEvents, which is directly linked to our online membership portal called myGS. This means your login for gsEvents is the same as your myGS login. Camp sessions fill up very quickly. Ensure you have several camp programs and session dates selected to increase your opportunity for getting into a program. We receive many phone calls and emails on the opening days of registration and as gsEvents is a new system, we have very limited "back office" functionality in assisting with camp registration. Please be patient with us – we're still learning too! Please check your account information at least one week before the opening day using the checklist below for a smoother registration process. Visit myGS at <https://mygs.girlscouts.org> to register for camp. You'll need to make sure you know the following for registration:

- ☐ myGS Login Information: (email address and password). Your login is the same as the one you use to access your membership. Once you log into your account, please check the following:
- ☐ Contact Information: Ensure all information for you and your camper is updated.
- ☐ Your camper is listed under your account and has an active 2021-2022 membership. If not, purchase a 2021-2022 membership for your camper. For assistance, contact [customercare@gscnc.org](mailto:customercare@gscnc.org).

This year, we're eliminating emergency contacts, tshirt sizes, and bus transportation from myGS registration. Bus transportation will be available to add on in the spring and the additional information will be collected in CampDoc.

## REGISTRATION DATES

To allow for a smoother registration process, we're spreading registration out over 2 days for each camp. The first half of the summer will open on Tuesday and the second half will open on Thursday. Registration will open each day at 10am.

- **January 11 at 10 AM:** Camp Potomac Woods Sessions 1-4 (June 12- July 8)
- **January 13 at 10 AM:** Camp Potomac Woods Sessions 5-8A (July 10- August 5)
- **January 25 at 10 AM :** Camp May Flather Sessions 2-5 (June 19- July 15)
- **January 27 at 10 AM :** Camp May Flather Sessions 6-9 (July 17- August 12)
- **March 22 at 10AM** Camp Winona Sessions 2-5 (June 19-July 15)
- **March 24 at 10AM** Camp Winona Session 6-9 (July 17-Aug 12)

What are Summer Day and Evening Camps?

Day and evening camps are for girls of all grades from K-12. Campers only attend during the day (or evening), just like going to sleep-away camp, but going home each evening. Camps range from one to two weeks and have a variety of themes – everything from nature and outdoor skills to Harry Potter and science exploration. There are outdoor camps, indoor camps, camps with overnights, and much more. Each camp is unique and run by caring adults. Adults can volunteer and come to camp with their camper!

How to Register & Registration Dates

Summer Day and Evening Camp registration will be through myGS at myGS.girlscouts.org. Before registration day, make sure your camper has an active membership for the 2021-2022 year and you know your myGS login information. Summer Day and Evening Camp registration is split into two days, by state.

February 15 at 10am: Virginia Summer Day and Evening Camps  
February 17 at 10am: Maryland Summer Day and Evening Camps

Some Summer Day and Evening Camps registration are by lottery. You'll still register on the day above, but instead of buying a spot in the camp, you are buying a "ticket" in the camp lottery. After the deadline passes the camp leadership team randomly selects campers from the "tickets" to be accepted into camp and notifies families.
