This list evolves constantly, as troops complete their service projects, and some of these tasks may have recently been completed. Please check with the Camp Caretaker for approval before commencing your project plan.

1. Adopt an existing trail and keep it trimmed, cleared and well marked.
2. Adopt an area/building/unit to keep maintained and clean including scrubbing tables and chairs, washing windows, wiping off fan blades and light fixtures.
3. Build a fire circle near Pond.
4. Split Stack and Deliver wood to each unit
5. Construct Dry Wood Huts for all units.
6. Paint and repair Picnic Tables.
7. Create new flower Beds with perennials (Cedar Lodge, Cafritz Lodge.)
8. Clean and reclaim Flower Beds (Promise Lodge and Laurel Lodge.)
9. Make benches for various spots around camp.
10. Create a Nature Center.
11. Rake ruts and re-seed grass where needed.
12. Cut back and clear undergrowth, vines and shrubbery.
13. Build flag stands and purchase flag(s) for each lodge.
14. Build shelves in cook shelters.
15. Make wooden benches
16. Research History of Camp including old photos and work with Archives Committee to display at camp.
