It's time to celebrate! National Girl Scout Week is here. Starting March 6, 2022, through March 12, 2022, join us as we honor the Girl Scout movement with a celebration. This celebration will observe Girl Scouts' birthday, March 12th. Girl Scout's birthday commemorates the day in 1912 when Juliette Gordon Low officially registered the first 18 Girl Scouts in Savannah, Georgia. Not only will we celebrate our birthday but we will enjoy our longstanding tradition of celebrating with faith communities. <u>Girl Scouts Celebrate Faith</u>, can be observed with any faith partner, by any faith group, on a day that works best for the partner and you. In general, the Christian holy day is Sunday, the Muslim Jummah holy day is Friday, and the Jewish Sabbath (Shabbat) holy day extends from sunset on Friday to sundown on Saturday.

Enjoy Girl Scout Sunday, Jummah, Shabbat, and Sabbath by wearing your uniform to your place of worship, working toward your My Promise, My Faith Award or Religious Recognition.

March 8 - Give Back to your Environment




