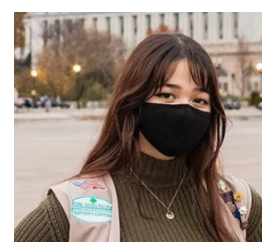

### March 8 - Girl Scout Sunday
