National Service Hours – Minimum of 25 hours

This category has been redefined as national service hours, with the understanding that government remains a partial requirement. Service to country and community is part of the Girl Scout tradition.

1. Government Hours – Minimum of 10 hours

Provide non-partisan service to federal, state or local government entities. This may include non-government entities that fulfill a governmental role such as the Kennedy Center, Smithsonian or Post Office.

2. Local Hours – Minimum of 5 hours

Service that fulfills a need in close proximity to your home, your school or your troop; either in your town or your county.

3. Green Hours – Minimum of 5 hours

Service that helps protect the environment.
