Scheduled Troop Camping Events through MD State Parks

Registration required, limited space available. This is a troop-only event (not for individuals).

<u>Troops MUST have their own cookout/campout and first-aid certified</u> adults to attend.

- Troops will participate in ranger-guided activities throughout the weekend and complete various badge requirements along the way!
- The \$12/girl, \$10/adult <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee directly funds the purchase of trees to be planted as a stewardship project during the events. Thank you for your donation! GSLSP patch is included in girl registrations.
- Open to Girl Scout Juniors and older.
- ◆ Teen scouts have the opportunity to earn service hours by assisting the rangers with programming for younger girls. All ages will complete steps towards at least one badge. If your teen troop is interested in assisting with programming, please email camp@gscnc.org prior to registration opening. Assisting troop spaces are limited.

- Registration required, limited space available in each session.
- This event is open to both individual families and troops.
- At least one person per family must have a 2022 GSCNC membership.
- Only Girl Scouts and Girl-Scout-aged tagalongs will need to register for sessions, but all attendees must register for the event.

Come Visit Cacapon Resort State Park for a fun-filled day of activities! **Sessions are offered** during the following timeslots: 10-10:45, 11-11:45, 1-1:45, 2-2:45, 3-3:45

All activities except kayaking are open to all levels/ages.

Available Sessions

Kayaking Safety- Enjoy learning the sport of kayaking and learning safety instructions. Enjoy the experience of kayaking on Cacapon's Lake. (Kayaks and life vests provided). Open to Brownies and older.

WV Tree Identification (three classes: 10,11, & 1)- Learn to identify some of WV most common trees while taking a short hike.

Intro to Backpacking (two classes: 2&3)- Learn the basics steps to prepare for camping and backpacking from a thru-hiker of the Appalachian and Pacific Crest trails.

Intro to Fishing- Learn the basics of fishing and enjoy casting out into the Cacapon's Lake. Fishing poles & bait provided.

Intro to Golf- Enjoy an introduction to the sport of golfing offered by the professional staff at Cacapon.

Art & Collage- Butterfly & wildlife projects and/or make nametags & friendship bracelets.

Pollinator Garden Tours/Monarchs- Tour the monarch way station at the nature center. Also, learn about the monarchs' journey.

WV Wildlife: Pelts, tracks, track mold- Learn about some common WV Wildlife and enjoy the hands-on experience of touching a variety of wildlife pelts. Participants can make and take a wildlife mold.

3RS: Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle!- Participants will interact with some fun, hands-on games and make some up-cycle crafts.


Leave No Trace- Plan ahead and prepare and pack in pack out principles with a fun game and craft.


