RULES OF ORDER

- All motions and resolutions shall be in written form and submitted to the Secretary.
- Speakers must state name and position.
- All remarks must be addressed to the Chair and must speak to the question under discussion.
- Each person speaking to a motion or resolution may have two minutes to speak.
- No one may speak twice until everyone wishing to speak has had the opportunity to do so.
- Questions regarding proposals to be considered at the meeting may be asked by the Council's Voting Members.
- Proposals considered at the Meeting are limited to those proposals specifically included in the notice of the meeting. Such proposals will be voted upon as presented.
- Each motion will be allotted five minutes; debates may be extended by a two-thirds vote or closed in less than five minutes by a motion to "call the question." A motion to call the question takes precedence over any motion on the floor and also requires a twothirds vote. If the motion is passed, an immediate vote on the question at hand is called.

Depression and anxiety

Bullying and peer pressure from social media

Self-image issues, low self confidence, body dysmophia and disordered eating

Academic achievement and performance pressures

Neurodivergence such as ADHD, learning disabilities, autism spectrum disorders and sensory issues

Fear or trauma through gun violence and family or societal dysfunctions

Personal identity issues with uncertainty over gender, sexuality, or how to support peers with similar questions

Peer Support group meetings

Forming Big Sis/Lil' Sis groups or 'Sister Troops'

Individual or group mentoring

Develop a crisis hotline for non-acute crisis situations for emotional connection

Additional caregivers and chaperones for monitoring atypical situations


Increase diversity in the adult volunteer space
