

## COUNCIL ANNUAL MEETING Saturday, April 20, 2024

## PROPOSED RULES OF ORDER

To facilitate debate, these Rules of Order are proposed. A two-thirds vote is required to adopt them.

- 1. All motions and resolutions shall be in written form and submitted to the Secretary.
- 2. Speakers must state name and position.
- 3. All remarks must be addressed to the chair and must speak to the question under discussion.
- 4. Each person speaking to a motion or resolution may have two minutes to speak.
- 5. No one may speak twice until everyone wishing to speak has had the opportunity to do so.
- 6. Questions regarding proposals to be considered at the meeting may be asked by the Council's Voting Members.
- 7. Proposals considered at the meeting are limited to those proposals specifically included in the notice of the meeting. Such proposals will be voted upon as presented.
- 8. Each motion will be allotted five minutes; debates may be extended by a two-thirds vote or closed in less than five minutes by a motion to "call the question." A motion to call the question takes precedence over any motion on the floor and also requires a two-thirds vote. If the motion is passed, an immediate vote on the question at hand is called.
