Summer Sleep Away Camps

When a Girl Scout leaves home and embraces camp life, they learn to make new friends and peers on even ground.

Girl Scouts Nation's Capital is excited to offer three overnight sleep away camps this summer at Camp May Flather, Camp Potomac Woods, and Camp Winona. Girl Scouts is about sharing fun, friendship, and the inherent power of girls and women in an inclusive, supportive, girl-led environment. Any girl—from kindergarten through 12th grade—can join Girl Scouts and attend camp. Additionally, if a family with a child of any other gender identity and expression (other than cisgender males) feels that Girl Scouting is the right community for them, they are welcome at Girl Scout Camp.

When campers sit around the campfire, paddle a canoe, shoot a bow and arrow, or climb a natural rock wall for the first time, something in them begins to change—they gain a sense of pride by facing their fears, they learn new skills and learn to make new friends. They come home with a spring in their step and a new light in their eyes.

Camp is transformative. At Girl Scout camp, campers ages 5–17 are encouraged to discover who they are and what they can become while gaining independence and self-confidence. Trained, caring staff respect and challenge campers, and campers gain a better understanding of themselves and their leadership potential. All Girl Scout camp programs are designed with campers' interests in mind to grow their passions and take healthy risks in a safe, supportive environment.



Get Ready for Adventure: Camp Registration Information

Sleep Away Camp registration has an Early Camper Placement Process (lottery) that takes place through Jotform.

You'll be able to indicate what programs your camper is interested in and if they would like to attend camp at the same time as a buddy or sibling. This takes place over the course of several weeks to allow everyone the opportunity to have their camper placed in their preferred program, this is not first come first serve. Placement emails will include an individualized link allowing you to register your camper for the program they have been placed in.

Day and Evening Camp Registration varies by camp.



While at camp, campers will enjoy meals provided by a professional food service, and full-week campers will cook at least one camper-led meal over the fire. Campers sleep on cots with mattresses, covered by a camp-provided bug net in screened glen shelters without electricity or air conditioning. Campers will enjoy awesome activities such as swimming at the pool, arts & crafts, outdoor cooking, STEM, and target sports like archery, slingshots, tomahawks, or knife throwing! But that's not all! Campers will also participate in many wonderful Camp Potomac Woods traditions, including campfires, singing, and maybe even a hike to explore the Pooh Tree or River Walk!


Forest Fairies

Junior counselors work a range of weeks at each camp (usually 3-4 weeks) but still go home over the weekend. Teens cannot be both a CIT and junior counselor in the same summer, at the same camp. Junior counselors who turn 18 during the summer may be given the option to apply for a full-time staff position. Applicants will be able to indicate on their applications if they are interested in specializing in lifeguarding, archery/slingshots, boating, program, and arts & crafts (opportunities depend on the camp).

Space is limited. All junior counselor applicants will be interviewed. Placement in the program is based on experience and is at the discretion of camp directors. Teens will receive a stipend for being a Junior Counselor.
