

- Select "gslearn" located under "My Account."


Where can I find required Troop Leader training?

On your gslearn homepage you will find "My Training."

Under "Not Started," select your program level and begin training! (Note, you should complete training for your troop's program level. If you're a Brownie leader, do the Brownie training!)

Important things to remember:

- Leaders must complete Troop Money Management in gslearn each year because finance guidelines change frequently!
- Leaders must complete the DEIA Commitment course in gsLearn just one time.
- All required troop leader training is on your gsLearn dashboard!

Teen Mental Health First Aid

Teen Mental Health First Aid is a certification designed for Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts, age 14 and up. High school is a time of critical change and development. It's when symptoms of mental health challenges may escalate and cause falling grades, problems with close relationships, and substance use.

Held in **six 45-minute virtual sessions** with independent coursework in between, this certification course gives teens the skills to have supportive conversations with their friends and teaches them how and when to get help from a responsible and trusted adult.

Topics include how to open conversations about mental health and substance use challenges, recognizing common signs and symptoms, and understanding the impact of school violence and bullying on mental wellbeing.

Time: 6:30 PM-7:15 PM

Fee: \$20 includes workbook

Location: Virtual with coursework in between sessions

Participants must be able to attend all sessions, 9/15, 9/22, 9/29, 10/6, 10/13, 10/20, from 6:30PM-7:15PM (Virtual/Independent) to be certified.

Highest Awards

Silver Trefoil Award



The Silver Trefoil Award is unique to Girl Scouts Nation's Capital. The award honors Girl Scout Seniors and Ambassadors who make the world a better place through service in three categories: Girl Scout Community, National, and Global.

Gold Award



Gold Award Girl Scouts have earned the highest award a Girl Scout Senior (grades 9-10) or Ambassador (grade 11-12) can earn. A Girl Scout earns this award as an individual once they have completed two Senior/Ambassador Journeys OR have earned the Silver Award and completed one Senior/Ambassador Journey. Girl Scouts track their progress using GSUSA's GoGold Platform and work with our local Gold Award Support Team.

Bronze Award



The Bronze Award is the highest award a Girl Scout Junior (grades 4-5) can earn. They can work with their troop, in a small group or as an individual to earn their Bronze Award once they have completed a Junior Journey.

Silver Award



Silver Award Girl Scouts have earned the highest award a Girl Scout Cadette (grades 6-8) can earn. A Girl Scout can work with their troop/group (a maximum of 3 per project is suggested) or as an individual to earn their Silver Award once they have completed a Cadette Journey.


Awards for All Girl Scout Levels

Journey Summit Award



This award is earned by completing three Journeys for your Girl Scout level.

Bridging Award



Bridging Girl Scouts earn this award by completing two steps: (1) Pass It On—to share what they've learned with younger Girl Scouts and (2) Look Ahead—to learn from older Girl Scouts about their next Girl Scout level.

Safety Award



This award is earned by completing three Journeys for your Girl Scout level.

My Promise, My Faith



Girl Scouts of all levels can earn one award each year as they explore the connection between Girl Scouts and their faith.

Meritorious Service

Bronze Cross



This Lifesaving Award is given to a Girl Scout who has shown extraordinary heroism or risked their life to save another's.

Medal of Honor



This Lifesaving Award is given to a Girl Scout who has saved someone's life in an emergency.

Volunteer in Training (VIT)

Girl Scouts will develop skills in creating supportive environments for younger kids.



Counselor in Training I

Girl Scouts will establish the leadership & outdoor skills needed to be a camp counselor.



Counselor in Training II

Girl Scouts will focus on skills needed to work with youth at camp, including behaviors of campers and how to manage them, working as a team with all staff, & learn about camp operations.
