

Girl Scout Cash Deposit Guide

Using Allpoint+ ATMs Successfully

Whether you're depositing funds from cookie sales, troop activities, or other events, here are some key tips to ensure your cash deposits go smoothly!



Before You Go: Prepare Your Deposit

Use Flat, Unwrinkled Bills

- ATMs may reject crumpled, torn, or folded bills.
- Flatten bills ahead of time for faster acceptance.

Know the Limits

- You can deposit up to \$5,000 per day.
- However, each individual deposit can only be:
 - \$1,000 at a time, OR
 - 100 bills at a time (whichever limit you reach first).

Sort Cash in Advance

- Group deposits into chunks of \$1,000 or fewer than 100 bills.
- Avoid mixing heavily worn bills if possible.

At the ATM: Best Practices

Take Your Time

- Insert bills slowly and carefully when prompted.
- If the ATM returns cash, remove it immediately and retry with a smaller batch.
- Always keep receipts from both successful and unsuccessful deposits

Minimize Failed Attempts

- Multiple rejected attempts can cause the ATM network to flag your account temporarily.
- Always double-check the condition and quantity of your bills before inserting.

If an Error Happens

- Cancel the transaction and start over with a smaller amount.
- If issues continue, use a different Allpoint+ ATM when possible.
