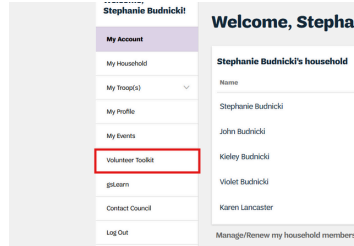
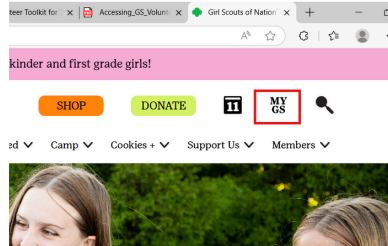


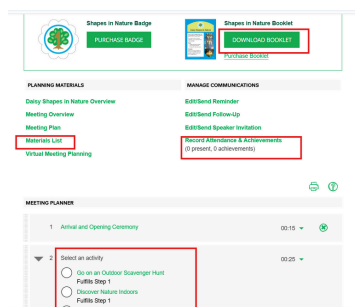
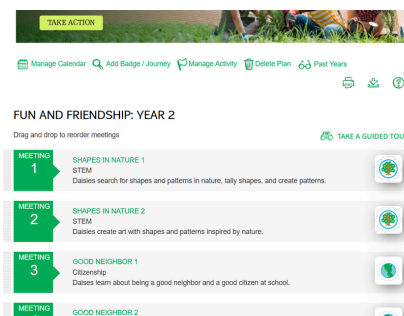
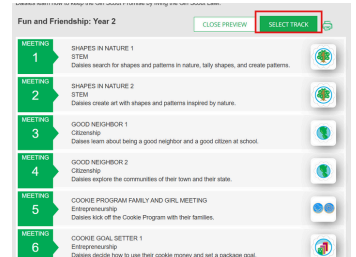
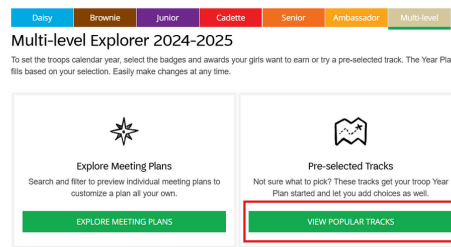
Volunteer Toolkit for Troop Leaders

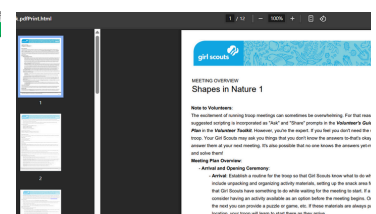
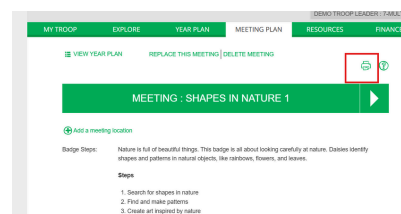
From the website: www.gscnc.org, click on ‘MY GS’ from the main navigation menu. Log In. Select ‘My Account’. Click on Volunteer Tool Kit.

The first time you log in you will be prompted to select a year plan. You can choose a preselected track and your entire year is already planned! Click on your Girl Scout Level and click on a track to preview. Once you have chosen a track, click “Select Track”. Once you set up your year plan, it is visible to all families in your troop. They can see and download the plans but cannot make changes. If you do not set up a year plan, caregivers will not see any badge information.



The year plan tab is your ultimate planning hub! Here, you’ll find all the badge plans laid out and ready to go. Want to dive deeper into a specific badge? Just click on the meeting to unlock the magic! From there, you can explore and choose activities, track attendance, view the materials list—you can even download the badge booklet.

Getting ready for meeting day? Just click the printer icon to print or download the full meeting plan! If you've already picked your favorite activity options, only those will show up. If you haven't, it'll include all the choices so you can decide later. This is a great way to share the plan with another caregiver who's helping out or leading a meeting.
