- I understand that the cookies have a set retail price of \$6.00. I agree not to sell Girl Scout Cookies for more than their set retail price.
- I understand that no orders will be taken before **December 13, 2024** and money will be collected upon delivery of cookies. Orders received for Gift of Caring programs can be paid for when the order is placed.
- **I accept responsibility and will meet all troop deadlines.** I agree to ensure product integrity and cookie care includes proper storage and handling practices. Product should be delivered promptly, and funds will be turned in **WEEKLY, to support all troop payment obligations** with full payment made no later than **March 19, 2025**.
- I understand all past due accounts may be referred to a collection agency if internal collection attempts fail.
- I understand that all proceeds are troop or council funds and **NOT** the property of my Girl Scout in accordance with Girl Scouts of the USA standards.
- I understand adults who support a youth member's selling effort are not eligible for youth member rewards.
- The council has my permission to use my Girl Scout's photograph/image to promote Girl Scouting. Yes No
